

All participating instructors are volunteers, and parents or guardians are welcome to participate. The workshop is intended to be an inspirational activity for students to learn about leadership. The Leader Development Workshop will introduce students to three pillars of leadership; including 14 leadership traits, 11 leadership principles, and 5 leadership styles. Students will analyze and discuss these attributes that, when combined and applied on a daily basis, can transform students into strong leaders. The students will also analyze and discuss leaders in American history and the decisions they made; evaluating the outcome of their decisions, good or bad.

Students can benefit from these leadership attributes. When taken to heart and applied on a daily basis, these attributes will help students make important decisions hereafter in elementary, middle, high school and beyond, which invariably will shape their future in a positive way.
